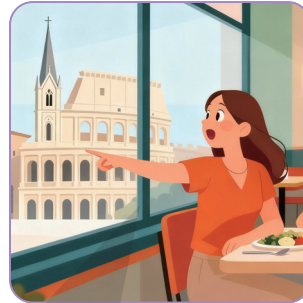

- Learn about Hong Kong's history and culture in a fun way.

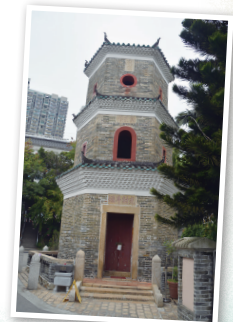
Useful information:
